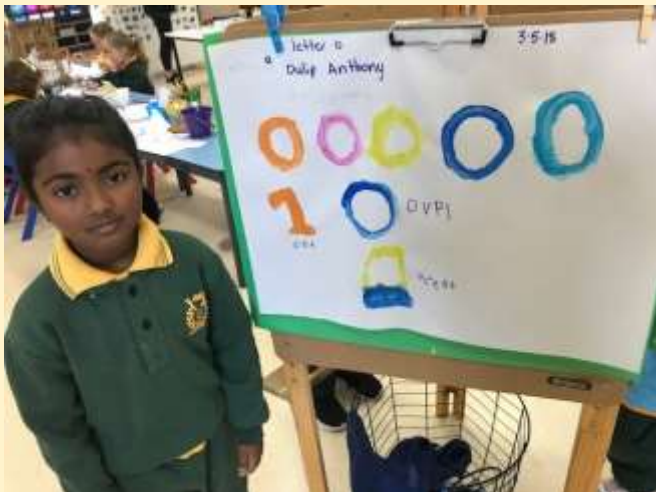
Welcome to Pre-Primary in Term 2!

In English, we are still focusing on recognising, naming and producing upper and lower case letters and on learning the common sound that each letter represents. To help us learn about the letter u and the letter o, we made collage umbrellas and orange juice. We love taking part in different activities to help us learn our sounds!

In English, we are also learning how to say and spell our surnames. We think that it is so interesting that we all have a second name and in class we revise the writing of our surnames every day! We are becoming so clever at writing our whole names!



In Mathematics, we are learning about numbers to 20 and beyond, 2D shapes and the days of the week! We enjoy singing songs and playing games to help us learn about these important concepts. We know there are seven days in a week and we are trying to order important events in a week and match them to days. For example, Monday is Digital Technology with Ms. Allen and Friday is Sport with Mr. White.
