Criteria:

- Applicants should be active practising and supportive members of St Jude's Parish Community.
- Applicants must be able to demonstrate the need for financial support with relevant supporting documentation.

If successful in your application, the scholarship will be available for all school age children in your immediate family (i.e. siblings) for their School Years at St Jude's Catholic Primary School.

Each year, to ensure continuation of the scholarship benefit, families must continue to be active practising and supportive members of St Jude's Parish and provide evidence of their continued need of financial support.

Please ensure that you have completed all sections of the application and have attached copies of the documents requested below.

Our Scholarship Program:

- Full Scholarship - covers all associated school fees (Note: this scholarship excludes external costs e.g. school uniforms, amenities, information technology and extended learning experiences)
- Tuition Scholarship - provides a discount of the Tuition Fee only. Parents must pay all other associated school fees and costs.

Process:

- St Jude's Catholic School will confirm in writing receipt of your completed application
- An interview with the Principal of St Jude's School and the Parish Priest will be arranged for Parents/Guardians and the student.
- All applicants will receive a letter from the Principal indicating the results of the application.

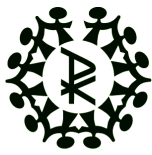
